

**Internship Announcement  
Santa Cruz Museum of Natural History  
Neary Lagoon Watershed Walk Program Internship**

The Museum seeks one college level intern to help coordinate and lead school tours in conjunction with its new Neary Lagoon Watershed Walk Program. The intern will work with Education staff to develop and maintain program materials, and will be responsible for leading 2-3 classroom presentations and/or field trips to Neary Lagoon per week for students in 5th grade. This program introduces students to the concepts of watersheds, water conservation, and water quality testing.

**Requirements:**

Candidates must 1) work well independently, 2) be comfortable working with a variety of demographic groups including staff, students, teachers, and the public, and 3) must be available during tour times: Monday- Friday varying times between the hours of 8:30 am- 3 pm from late September until early December, 2010.

**Compensation:**

A \$500 stipend will be paid to the intern upon completion and fulfillment of contract, and the intern may receive college credit.
