### How Healthy are Our Coastal Lagoons?

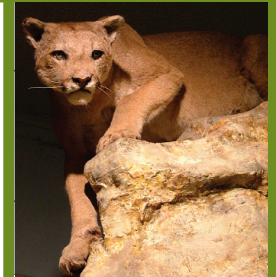
How do scientists assess the health of our estuaries? Join the Central Coast Wetlands Group on their journey to develop a method for monitoring the health of these coastal treasures.
