Play a Game

The Hand Game

This game is played with two wooden or bone pieces that are the same size. One of the pieces is marked with a string, one is plain. One player puts their hands behind their back and hides a piece in each hand. The other player then tries to guess which hand has the marked piece. If the player guesses correctly, they get to hide the pieces for the next turn. If the player guesses incorrectly, the first player gets to hide the pieces again.

Acorn crackers!

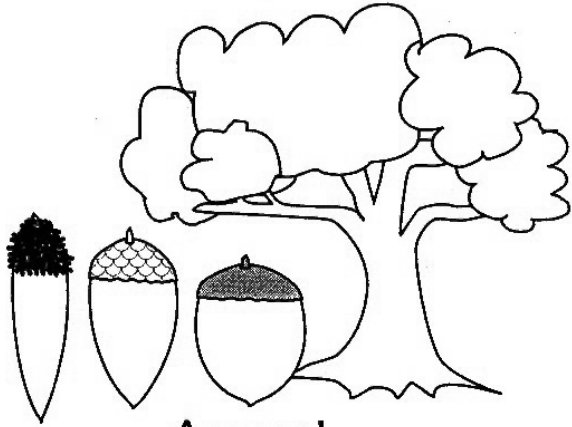

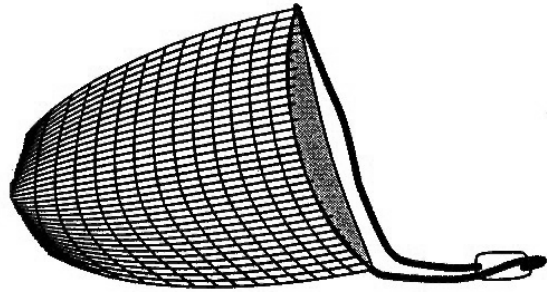

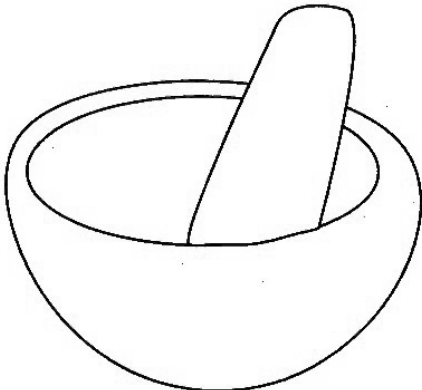
Acorn Mush



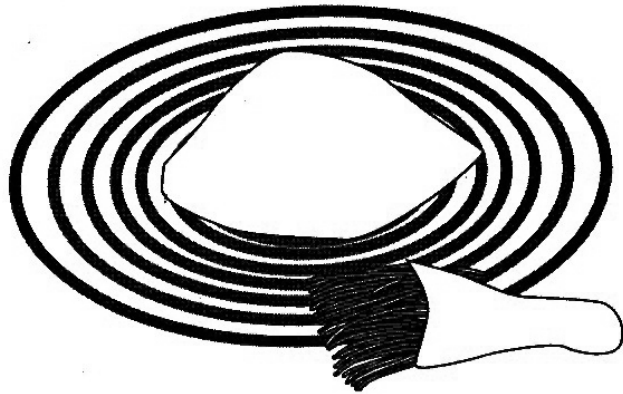
Acorns!



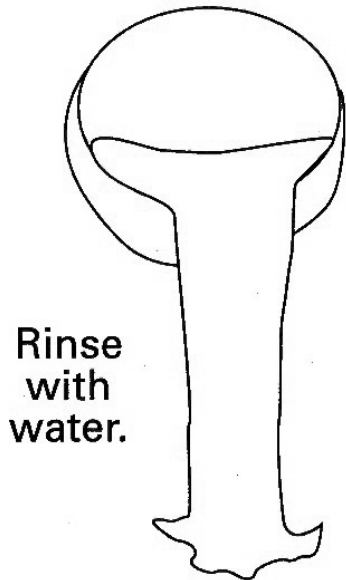
Gather in a basket.



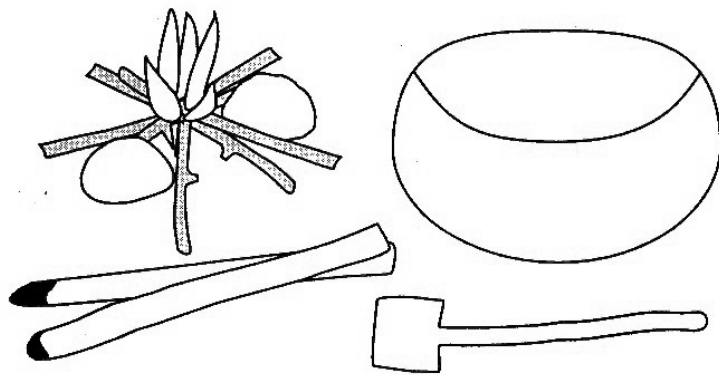
Pound! Pound!
